5 Welcome Home tips

1. Take your dog directly home - newly adopted dogs are a flight risk.
2. Take your dog to a potty spot and wait for him to potty before going into your home.
3. Do not bathe your dog for the first few days - bathing in a new place may scare him.
4. Get to know your dog before inviting friends and family to meet her. Supervise dog and child interactions.
5. Focus on mistake-free learning, let your home do the teaching! Put away toys, shoes, and laundry.
